Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements should be made **at least six months** in advance by calling for an appointment with the Parish Priest. The six months' notice is required to ensure the proper paperwork can be finalized and guaranteed. There will be no exceptions. A marriage preparation course is **mandatory** in our Diocese.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registering for baptism. Baptism preparation class is mandatory and must be completed prior to booking a date for baptism. To book a date for baptism **you must give two months notice.**

SACRAMENTS



Confirmation is for people 12 years old or older, including adults. Candidates need all three Sacraments prior to being Confirmed.

Children who have completed Grade 1 by the end of June are eligible to start classes for Reconciliation then go straight on to First Eucharist later the same year if desired. Watch the Bulletin for updates and start dates.

Baptism, First Eucharist, and Reconciliation certificates are required for all Sacraments.

Registration is now open.

Reconciliation - Thursday, 5-6, starting Oct. 13 - Grade 2 or older
First Eucharist - Wednesday 530-630, starting January – Grade 2 or older, having received Reconciliation first
Confirmation - Wednesday 4-5, starting January – Grade 6 or older, having received both Reconciliation and Eucharist.

Baptism certificates for all sacraments are required. Those Baptized at St. Mary's or Tide Lake churches have them on file. If you have received any sacraments at St. Mary's, your Baptism certificates may also be on file. Check with the church. To receive Confirmation, First Eucharist, and ideally Reconciliation, certificates are required.

It is possible to receive all 3 sacraments in this school year.

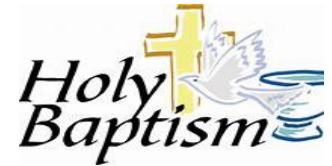

In this Month of The Holy Rosary, let us join together as a prayer community. Please invite your friends and family!!

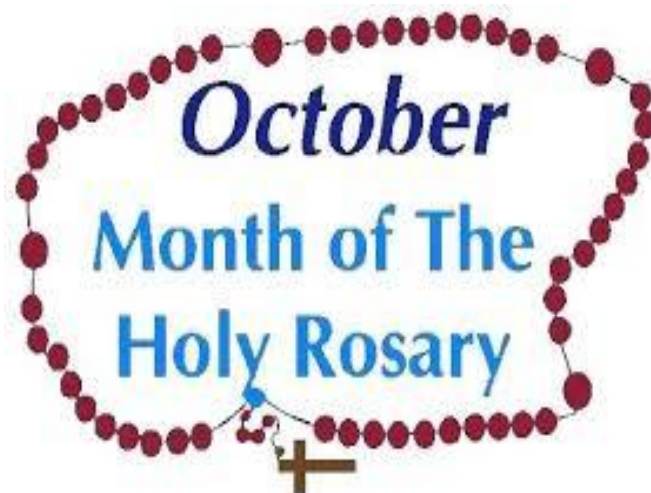
Plan to arrive early, so that you may be seated ahead of our start time.

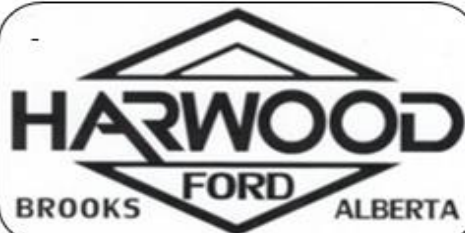
