HOLY SACRAMENTS

(Baptism, Reconciliation, First Communion, Confirmation, Marriage, Holy Orders & Anointing of the Sick)

People who wish to receive any of the Holy Sacraments must be a registered parishioner of St. Mary's Parish: Brooks + Tide Lake Mission.

For Baptisms, all requirements must be completed before booking a Baptism date. At least two months notice must be given in order to complete all the requirements.

For Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation, all requirements, including classes/sessions must be completed to be eligible for Sacraments.

For Marriages, all requirements must be completed before booking a Marriage date. At least six months notice must be given in order to ensure the proper paperwork can be finalized and guaranteed. There will be no exceptions.

The proper order of receiving the Holy Sacraments are; (1st) Baptism, (2nd) Reconciliation, (3rd) First Communion, (4th) Confirmation, (5th) Marriage or (5th) Holy Orders - if going to priesthood. People are not eligible get the next sacrament without receiving the previous one; (example: A person cannot receive the First Communion without receiving his/her Reconciliation first.)

A message from the Society of St. Vincent de Paul - Brooks:

Thank you to all, for your support, for the ongoing prayers for our clients, and trusting us as Vincentian servants in this amazing ministry. Over the many years, through food hampers, and monetary aid, we have been able to assist those less fortunate. Our prayer has always been, and will always be that those created in God's image but struggling, will be treated with great dignity, gentle patience, and love. That is what St. Vincent stood for, and what our founder Blessed Fredric Ozanam expected from this Society.

But, as times change, after much deliberation, and discussion, we have decided it is time to reevaluate how we are helping those in need. Is it still effective, is food collected being used or discarded? With honest sharing, it was decided that going forward, and as the pantry empties, we will be transitioning to collecting only monetary funds. We will no longer be collecting groceries. Donation envelopes and other opportunities will be available. The generosity of your funds, will allow us to purchase grocery gift cards from No Frills, hamburger, and continue to aid clients with shelter, clothing, and at times misc. things, such as medical prescriptions.

Just recently, we have partnered with KFC, and Cobbs Bread (thank you to a generous offer) to be able to offer something more, and to reduce food waste. We will be collecting from KFC, once a week, food safe, frozen cooked chicken that was prepared, but did not sell, and at present working with Cobbs for some of their yummy bread that cannot be sold. Families that struggle to make ends meet, will hopefully feel some hope and joy when they encounter our ministry - being the hands and feet of Christ.

To summarize, there are about 4 points we would like to bring forward regarding this transition, and encourage any questions/concerns: (Patti, Mona, Linda, Denise, Reg)

- 1. Cut down on food waste clients can purchase what they will eat.
- 2. With our wonderful, different ethnic groups, they can shop for their needs.
- 3. Different health issues allergies, diabetes
- 4. Those with no fixed addresses will have an alternate, dignified way to access food.





HOLY FAMILY CONFERENCE (Apr. 28-29, 2023)


