#### **HOLY SACRAMENTS**

(Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Communion, Confirmation, Marriage/Holy Matrimony, Holy Orders & Anointing of the Sick)

People who wish to receive any of the Holy Sacraments must be a registered parishioner of St. Mary's Parish: Brooks + Tide Lake Mission.

For Baptisms, all requirements must be completed before booking a Baptism date. At least two months notice must be given in order to complete all the requirements.


For Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation, all requirements, including classes/sessions must be completed to be eligible for Sacraments.

For Marriages, all requirements must be completed before booking a Marriage date. At least six months notice must be given in order to ensure the proper paperwork can be finalized and guaranteed. There will be no exceptions.

## SACRAMENT PREPARATION FOR FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION 2023

Sacrament Preparation for First Reconciliation will be starting up soon! First Communion and Confirmation will be starting up in the winter.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR FIRST RECONCILIATION IS ON OCTOBER 13, 2023 (FRIDAY)

If you are thinking about registering, but have not done so yet, **PLEASE GET THE FORMS IN.** Our schedule may change and I want you to be aware of those changes.

Our schedule is as follows:

**Tuesdays, starting Oct. 17th from 5-6pm.** This is for both parents and children.

Fridays, starting Oct. 13th (this may change!!!!) from 12:30-1:30pm. It is up to the parents to get your children to the church and let us know about after our sessions. If they are to go to a school, we need to know that. Or if they are in an after school program, they need to be able to get there. Or if they are pickup, we need to know that. Or if they are to stay with us until 230, let us know. Parents, if you are able to come to the sessions for the parents, I would have a session.

Parent only sessions - Mondays, from 7-8pm, starting Oct. 23rd

- Tuesdays, from 745-845pm. (This is after the evening Mass.) Starting Oct. 17th

It is your responsibility to attend the sessions weekly, both for the children and the parents.

Confirmation children - do you have your Sacrament of Reconciliation? Classes and completion of the Sacrament of Reconciliation MUST be done before Confirmation. There will not be any Reconciliation classes in 2024 before Confirmation.



#### Who can go to Adoration?


