HOLY SACRAMENTS

(Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Communion, Confirmation, Marriage/Holy Matrimony, Holy Orders & Anointing of the Sick)

People who wish to receive any of the Holy Sacraments must be a registered parishioner of St. Mary's Parish: Brooks + Tide Lake Mission.

For Baptisms, all requirements must be completed before booking a Baptism date. At least two months notice must be given in order to complete all the requirements.


For Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation, all requirements, including classes/sessions must be completed to be eligible for Sacraments.

For Marriages, all requirements must be completed before booking a Marriage date. At least six months notice must be given in order to ensure the proper paperwork can be finalized and guaranteed. There will be no exceptions.

SACRAMENT PREPARATION FOR, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION 2023

The registrations for Holy Eucharist are being accepted at the church office. If your child has not yet started Reconciliation and they need it before they start Eucharist classes, you will have to wait until next year.

If you are already doing the Reconciliation classes, you will be already registered, unless you tell me otherwise. Classes will start in mid-February. **Deadline will be Dec. 15th. 2023.**

Confirmation classes will start mid-January. If they have received both Reconciliation and Eucharist, they just need to register for Confirmation and provide the dates of the previous Sacraments and certificates, if available.

If they are also receiving Eucharist in the spring, they will be in two classes, but different times. If you need the sponsor's certificate, please register and make a note of the need of the sponsor's certificate.

First Communion Registration Deadline is Dec. 15, 2023

How would you like to help young people grow in their faith?

We are looking for Catechists to help with Eucharist and Confirmation sessions.

For Holy Eucharist, we have need of a Catechist for Wednesdays at 515-615pm. We also need a Catechist for Friday from 1230-130pm. The Holy Eucharist book is complete and comes with a manual to guide to lessons.

For Confirmation - our days are not set, but aiming for Thursday, finishing before 630pm. Other options might be available, depending on responses of kids, catechists, and space available.

Volunteer paperwork is required including parish registration. A good understanding of the Catholic faith and regular participation at Mass is a valuable asset.

Meditation:



4th Sunday of Advent Dec. 24 - LOVE(Angel's candle) we eagerly await the new kingdom of God on earth.


