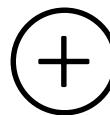

HOLY SACRAMENTS

(Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Communion, Confirmation, Marriage/Holy Matrimony, Holy Orders & Anointing of the Sick)

People who wish to receive any of the Holy Sacraments **must be a REGISTERED PARISHIONER of St. Mary's Parish: Brooks + Tide Lake Mission.**

For Baptisms, **all requirements must be completed before booking a Baptism date. At least TWO MONTHS NOTICE must be given** in order to complete all the requirements.

For Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation, **all requirements, including classes/sessions MUST BE COMPLETED to be eligible for Sacraments.**

For Marriages, **all requirements must be completed before booking a Marriage date. At least SIX MONTHS NOTICE must be given** in order to ensure the proper paperwork can be finalized and guaranteed. There will be no exceptions.
